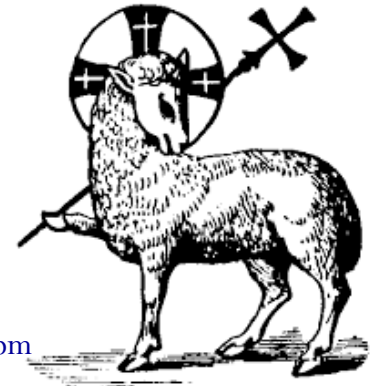

**THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH**

**The Signs of Bread and Wine**

**1335** The miracles of the multiplication of the loaves, when the Lord says the blessing, breaks and distributes the

loaves through his disciples to feed the multitude, prefigure the superabundance of this unique bread of his Eucharist. The sign of water turned into wine at Cana already announces the hour of Jesus' glorification. It makes manifest the fulfillment of the wedding feast in the Father's kingdom, where the faithful will drink the new wine that has become the Blood of Christ.

**1336** The first announcement of the Eucharist divided the disciples, just as the announcement of the Passion scandalized them: "This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?" The Eucharist and the Cross are stumbling blocks. It is the same mystery and it never ceases to be an occasion of division. "Will you also go away?": the Lord's question echoes through the ages, as a loving invitation to discover that only he has "the words of eternal life" and that to receive in faith the gift of his Eucharist is to receive the Lord himself.

**CATECISMO DE LA IGLESIA CATOLICA**

**Los signos del pan y del vino**

**1335** Los milagros de la multiplicación de los panes, cuando el Señor dijo la bendición, partió y distribuyó los panes por medio de sus discípulos para alimentar la multitud, prefiguran la sobreabundancia de este único pan de su Eucaristía (cf. Mt 14,13-21; 15, 32-29). El signo del agua convertida en vino en Caná (cf. Jn 2,11) anuncia ya la Hora de la glorificación de Jesús. Manifiesta el cumplimiento del banquete de las bodas en el Reino del Padre, donde los fieles beberán el vino nuevo (cf. Mc 14,25) convertido en Sangre de Cristo.

**1336** El primer anuncio de la Eucaristía dividió a los discípulos, igual que el anuncio de la pasión los escandalizó: "Es duro este lenguaje, ¿quién puede escucharlo?" (Jn 6,60). La Eucaristía y la cruz son piedras de escándalo. Es el mismo misterio, y no cesa de ser ocasión de división. "¿También vosotros queréis marcharos?" (Jn 6,67): esta pregunta del Señor resuena a través de las edades, como invitación de su amor a descubrir que sólo Él tiene "palabras de vida eterna" (Jn 6,68), y que acoger en la fe el don de su Eucaristía es acogerlo a Él mismo.

From the time of the early Christians, the book of Revelation has fascinated and puzzled its readers in equal measure. Known as the Apocalypse of John, Revelation has left a profound mark on Western culture. For many, however, Revelation remains a mystery, and it is rarely preached or read at Sunday Masses.

*The Victory of Christ: Exploring the Book of Revelation* is a fascinating journey through this influential yet puzzling book: its origins; the apocalyptic writings in the early church; how its original audience might have understood the text, and how it has been interpreted throughout the ages providing insights into the New Testament. Plan to explore its mysterious descriptions of the heavenly world: its powerful visions of plagues and cosmic disaster; its description of the New Jerusalem, and vital questions about John's apocalyptic vision. Finally, the book's self-designation as "a revelation of Jesus Christ" will focus on Christ's victory over the forces of evil and chaos, providing a sense of hope and understanding of the word of God.

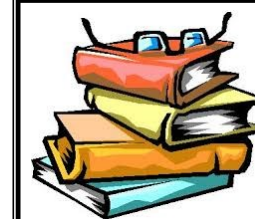
**LADIES GUILD MEETING**
