Communications;

Public safety Officer: Phil presented CPD-023 Custodial Interrogation explain the document. He then moved on to CPD-031 Active shooter, Barricade/Hostage. Phil explain to the council how important it was in this day that when an officer comes on the scene that all the neighboring officers are following the same policy. Phil then followed up on CPD- 052 Physical Tactic. He asked for question and there were none.

Marshal: Monthly police report was given to the Clerk. The first 59 days call for service was 321, Police service 175 and traffic arrest 54. Levi is on his own now and we will be swearing in the two new Deputy Marshal later this evening. Both will be going to the Academy in June and it will graduate in Sept. No questions form the audience
Fire Chief: Kerry reported Feb the CVFD had 53 runs. 19 was in the Town, 5 was in Taylor Twp., 14 was in Cloverdale Twp., 6 in Warren and the rest in surrounding area. No questions for the Fire Chief. Dale (Cloverdale trustee) came before the council asking for money from this year budget. The Clerk explain that the budget was set and if there was any extra money at the end of the year Dale could come back in Oct requesting what he needed then.

Clerk Treasurer: Ask permission to purchase two police radio for \$8,190.76 Larry made the motion and Don 2nd vote was unanimous. Mid-Western can calculate the current value of our water and wastewater infrastructure. Based on 3 hours of work in the amount of \$500.00. Motion to approve was made by Larry and 2nd by Cindy the vote was unanimous. In your packet you will find how the budget was disbursed does the council have any question. No question.

Town Manager: 65 work orders. In your packet are two Quotes one from Mid-State for \$8,260.00 and the second from Reading Truck equipment for \$6,673.75 to replace the bed on the little dump truck. The Town is no longer on the Agreed Order with IDEM.

Redevelopment: Minutes are on line.

Building Inspector: monthly report on the web site. Two residential permits, one electrical upgrade, One re-roof and one Commercial permit. New home on CR425. Home at 301 N. Main will be putting \$44,000 for a new porch, painting along with a new roof etc. Floyd Freeman is building a new House and Whispering Winds has three more in the works.

New Business:

FNB will lease the Town a 2017 Police car for \$10,348.57 for the next three years for the total price of \$30,439.52. Being paid out of CCD fund. Motion was made by Gary and 2nd by Don to approve the Lease and to let Cheryl Galloway sign the appropriate paper work from the Bank.

Resolution 2018-1 Clear the books of Old outstanding checks. Motion to approve was made by Cindy and 2nd by Larry. Vote was unanimous

Resolution 2018-2 approve the Comprehensive Plan contingent to final approval from OCRA. Motion to approve was made by Cindy and 2nd by Larry. Vote was unanimous. We held a Public Hearing today at 3:30p.m.

Resolution 2018-3 Transfer \$114,903.30 from the General account to the Rainy Day.

Redact Resolution 2017-18. Motion to approve was made by Don and 2nd by Larry. Vote was unanimous.

Main Street requesting that the Town Hall host the Christmas Carriage ride. Motion to approve was made by Larry and 2nd by Cindy. Vote was unanimous.

Old Business

Open sealed Farm bids for the farm ground at the water plant. There was one turned in by Chad Cummins for \$600.00 Motion to approve was made by Larry and 2nd by Gary. Vote was unanimous. \$500.00 was paid last Year
Appointment for the Animal control Board. The Council appointed Stephanie Hoffa Motion was made by Gary 2nd by Cindy. Vote was unanimous.

The Demo for 131 Blue Side Way has been completed and Wayne inspected the property and approve moving forward with payment of \$4,700 to Rays Demolition. Motion to approve was made by Cindy and 2nd by Larry. Vote was unanimous. Comments from the Audience. Dan ask what happen to the sign out front. Wayne is working on it.

Coweta asked Sheriff Stockton to come forward. Coweta explain how it came about that the Town was able to hire Marshal Hibler and get Public Safety Advisor Phil Parker to build the solid foundation for the CPD with the adopted Indiana State Police SOP. Sheriff Stockton took the opportunity to announce that Greencastle will be holding a meeting March 21st at 6:30. They will host a School safety expert that will talk about school shooting and soft spots of large crowds.
