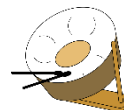
Dominican Republic

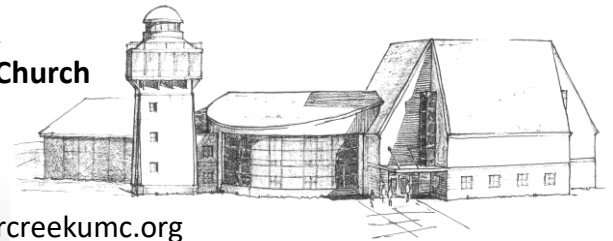
Thank You, Ride For The Refuge Volunteers!
