

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cloverdale, County of Putnam, State of Indiana:

SECTION #1: That permission and authority is hereby given and granted to the STANDARD OIL COMPANY, a corporation organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Indiana, to construct and maintain for a term of fifty years, on the following described property, to-wit:

Lot #3 in T. M. Layne's addition to the Town of Cloverdale, Putnam County, Indiana.

warehouse, tanks and other buildings necessary for its business and to store therein illuminating oils, coal oils, naphtha, gasoline, benzine or any other mineral oil or fluid, the products of petroleum, in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of its said business; said permission is granted upon the conditions that said company be liable for all damages that may result from the construction and maintenance of said tanks and other buildings.

SECTION #2: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION #3: This ordinance shall be in force and effect on and after its passage and acceptance in writing by the said STANDARD OIL COMPANY.
