Divine Mercy Sunday: Jesus, I trust in You!

Today on the Second Sunday of Easter we observe what is called 'Divine Mercy Sunday.' It was given this title in large part because of the revelations by Jesus granted to St. Faustina Kowalksa, a Polish nun who died in the year 1938. These revelations have been approved by the Church as worthy of belief, and containing nothing that is contrary to the teaching of the Church. In these revelations, which are recorded in St. Faustina's famous *Diary*, Jesus expresses to St. Faustina His desire for the message of His unfathomable Divine Mercy to be spread throughout the world, especially to the hardest of sinners. Jesus asked that the 'Feast of Mercy' be established and celebrated on the Second Sunday of Easter. Here is what He told her: "My daughter, tell the whole world about My inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and a shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day are opened all the divine flood-gates through graces flow. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. Everything that exists has come from the very depths of My most tender mercy. Every soul in its relation to Me will contemplate My love and mercy throughout eternity. The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My mercy" (*Diary*, 699). Jesus also told St. Faustina to have an image of His mercy commissioned. A rendition of this famous image is displayed on the right side of our sanctuary, showing the pale and red rays emitting from the Heart of Jesus, a reminder of the Blood and Water which gushed forth from His Heart when it was pierced by the lance as He hung on the Cross. In this Easter season we are called to turn more fully to Christ in confident hope and joy, being receptive to the many mercies. He offers to us, just as He offered to His Apostles when He appeared to them after the Resurrection and said, "Peace be to you." On this Divine Mercy Sunday, let us turn towards the merciful Lord, seeking to abandon that which leads us away from Him, and trusting in His goodness, follow Him with greater love and devotion. At 3:00pm on this Divine Mercy Sunday, we will have a Holy Hour at Guardian Angel during which the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will be sung, and there will be an opportunity for quiet prayer and confessions. An incredible indulgence may be received this day, as Our Lord spoke about in His revelations to St. Faustina. Jesus, I trust in You!
