

An Independent Movement for Palestinian Rights, Growing in the Grassroots of The United Methodist Church



They called to us from the city of Christ's birth, in the Christmas season of 2009. Palestinian Christians sent the world a heartfelt message of faith, hope and love...and an urgent call to action: Kairos Palestine: A Moment of Truth. In October 2010, United Methodists for Kairos Response (UMKR) was born. From a small group of 25 activists, UMKR has grown into a multi-faceted, diverse movement of thousands of laity and clergy throughout the denomination.

For decades, the Palestinian people have endured crimes against humanity under a brutal military occupation: rampant ethnic cleansing and state-sanctioned murder; massive destruction of homes, businesses, and farmland; and thousands of children arrested and abused. The illegal Separation Wall, hundreds of checkpoints, and the devastating blockade of Gaza have turned their communities into virtual prisons. Christians and all people of conscience must answer the Kairos Palestine call to help end this suffering.

Political Advocacy

To achieve a just peace, all governments, and especially the U.S., must withdraw funding and support for Israeli oppression of the indigenous people of Palestine. At our website, SUBSCRIBE to News & Action to join thousands of advocates who are making an impact in the halls of power.

Boycott & Divestment

Kairos Palestine tells us that boycotts and divestment are powerful tools to achieve justice in the Holy Land. Our church has called for a global ban on products from the Israeli settlements on Palestinian land! Also, after years of internal church activism, the UMC made headlines globally by divesting from Israeli banks and other businesses, due to their complicity in violating Palestinian rights. We can work together to continue this powerful B&D action!
