Howard "Bud" Joseph Rollo, 86, of Caseville, passed away on Friday, June 6, 2025, at Covenant Medical Center Cooper in Saginaw. Bud was born May 7, 1939, in Detroit, Michigan, to the late Howard and Irene (Goniwicka) Rollo and was a 1957 graduate of St. Joseph's High School. He proudly served the community of Warren as a Police Officer until his retirement as a Sargeant in 1986. Bud married Loretta Evans in 1978, and the couple shared over 47 years together. She survives him.
