SHOOTING SPORTS

Pistol Committee

We did have a long range egg shoot on January 1st, and it was a good time. It is probable we will do it again in February and March unless the weather is really bad. Check our blog periodically to find out what we're up to at the link below. By March it is likely all of our matches will be back in full swing as long as weather cooperates. This year we will have USPSA matches on the third Sunday of the month, and Multi-Gun matches on the second Sunday of the month. Both of these do require all ranges including the trap fields and rifle range to be closed until about 3:00 pm. Fun Shoots now come in several different flavors. We shoot long range 22lr with rifles on the rifle range in January, February, March and June and these do require closing the rifle range. We will shoot falling steel with pistols or pistols caliber carbines in the back pits only in April, May, July and August and ranges are left open for member use. We will shoot back pit egg shoots with 22lr rifles and pistols in September, October, November and December and ranges will be left open for member use.
