Fees and Commitments

Application Fee -- \$75

This non-refundable fee must accompany the application prior to additional admission procedures. This fee is paid only once during the time the child attends Amare Montessori. If the child leaves and returns to Amare Montessori the fee may be waived upon re-enrollment.

Enrollment Fee for New Students -- \$200

This non-refundable fee is due at the time the student is accepted. The completed Enrollment Packet is due within 10 days of accepting an offered space.

Re-Enrollment of Current Students -- \$125

This non-refundable annual fee is due yearly in late winter. Re-enrollment fee is pro-rated (\$75.00) for those families who initially enrolled between January and May.

Mandatory Fees/Expenses

1. Field Trip Fees (Elementary) will be due at the time of each trip. Payment is expected with the return



of each permission slip. Total cost for field trips each year will be approximately \$100 per Lower Elementary student and \$150 per Upper Elementary student.

2. School Bag: Each child will need to purchase an Amare Montessori school bag from Keelyn Kreations. (Back & Forth Bag for Toddler and Primary; Backpack for Elementary).



- 3. Raincoat and Boots: All students are required to have a raincoat and rain boots at school.
- Sharing Basket: Each student will be put on a weekly rotation to bring snacks and consumable supplies for their class. Approximate cost per turn: \$65 (Number of turns throughout the year will be dependent on enrollment in each classroom.)
- 5. School Supply List: Each class will have a school supply list at the beginning of the academic year that families are responsible for. Approximate cost per student: \$85-100.
- 6. Supply Fee: \$100 for Toddler and Primary and \$150 for Elementary, due with the Enrollment Packet or Re-Enrollment Form.
