QUINCEAÑERA INFORMATION SHEET

We welcome you and your family to celebrate your daughter's Quinceañera here at Saint Kateri Tekakwitha Community. Our focus is on the liturgical celebration which will take place in the church. Although the celebration of Quince Años is not a sacrament, the sacraments of Eucharist and Penance are an integral part of the preparation. Below are some guidelines to assist you in having a meaningful and joyful ceremony:

- The Quinceañera should be scheduled 6 months in advance.
- The Quinceañera Mass requires a deposit to reserve your date. Please call the parish office for pricing information.
- Music for the Mass is required. You may contact any of the follow parish Music Ministers or discuss with the Coordinator another appropriate group.

Musicians' fees vary and are the responsibility of the Quinceañera Family.

- A Quinceañera Coordinator will assist you in selecting the Readings for the Mass, conduct the Rehearsal and will also be present on the day of the celebration.
 - Please contact the Beaumont office NO LATER than 1 MONTH prior to the Celebration.
- The rehearsal is a very important part of the preparation for the celebration. Please Schedule the rehearsal with the Quinceañera Coordinator at a time when all the necessary Participants can be present.
- In decorating the church the use of nails, tacks, and tape are not permitted. Neither confetti nor "bubbles" may be used in or around the church.
- The only gifts that may be blessed are: A bible, religious medals, a ring which symbolizes the girl's tie and responsibility to God and the community, a crown, symbolizing the victory the young lady has won in trying to live a Christian life, and flowers, symbolizing new life.
- Families must be registered in the Parish.
- Young ladies need to be participating in one of the following groups:

 Confirmation or Youth Group. She needs to attend weekly Mass and have celebrant sign card as proof of attendance.
- There is limited photography permitted during the celebration, please discuss this with the Quinceañera Coordinator.
- If the Quinceañera participant is 15 minutes late of scheduled time, the priest will start the Mass even without her and the renewal of Baptism promise will be done after Communion. Remember that there are other celebrations scheduled after the Mass.
