Board of Trustees Meeting

July 17, 2017

The regular meeting was called to order by President Kevin Sluder at 7:00 p.m., Monday July 17, 2017. Responding to roll call were Bob Steele, Mike Supan Jr., Heather Sherman, Dave Wiesbrock, Bob Foly, Tom Goskusky, Bob Anderson, Todd Anderson and Jessica Bonnell. ## **Village Clerk Report - Heather Sherman**

- La Salle County board minutes are available to board members who request them.
- The minutes of June's meeting were presented and approved. A motion was made by Bob Foly and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Supan Jr.
- Water bills will be mailed tomorrow.

## **Treasurer Report - Jessica Bonnell**

- Monthly bills were presented and approved to pay. A motion was made by Todd Anderson and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dave Wiesbrock.

## **Water & Sewer/Streets & Alley Report - Marc Lemrise**

- The park bathrooms were vandalized again. They were cleaned up and working again.
- Hydrant flushing and fixing potholes has been going on around town.
- Derek signed up for ERTC training on clarifiers.

## **Engineer's Report - Jack Kusek**

- A motion was made by Bob Anderson and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bob Foly for a pay request made by Vissering Construction in the amount of \$33,323.26 for the new water treatment plant.

- Third street hasn't been worked on in over 20 years but is in decent condition. Lowell Farm Drainage will need to get a survey done before an estimate can be done.
- For the last two weeks a control technician has been working the kinks out of the new sewer treatment plant.
- The Circle Drive drainage estimate came in at \$8,612.90. After some discussion the board decided to ask for a less extensive estimate to fix the drainage issues. A motion was made by Bob Anderson and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom Goskusky to allow Lowell Farm Drainage to fix the drainage issues but not to exceed the amount of the original estimate.

### **Attorney's Report - Robert Steele**

- Brian Obermiller owner of Obermiller Kustom Fabrication has made a request to be reimbursed through the TIF for work he did to his business over 3 years ago. Klein & Assoc the village's TIF specialists will be contacted on this matter.
- A motion to pass Resolution #599 Proposed TIF District Redevelopment Project was made by Dave Wiesbrock and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mike Supan Jr.

### **Trustees Comments & Complaints**

- The Army Corp of Engineers has approved a team to access the creek bank that runs through the edge of the Tonica Cemetery's property to decide if the Federal Government can fix the erosion on the creek bank.
- Special recognition goes out to Art & Joyce Lund who walk daily through town and pickup garbage.
