

GREENBUSH MINUTES

July 22, 2019

Treasure Roof was absent all other present. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Thelen at 7:00 p.m.

Correspondence - There were letters sent to the board concerning two areas in the township that needed to be cleaned up. Supervisor Thelen explained that you may submit to the zoning in writing and that they will then proceed to take the necessary steps. They will usually have 30 days to answer complaint. Also, Joe Haviland that works for zoning can send a letter if he is just driving around and see infractions.

Public Comment – Art Wainwright spoke on why there is a need for a road milage. Supervisor Thelen explained the township can maintain the roads in their present state, with the present budget but needs a milage to improve the roads in the near future.

Clint Barry asked why some of the roads aren't holding up better such as DeWitt Rd. where he lives. Supervisor Thelen stated that the roads were better but they had been in such bad shape so long it will take time.
