

Preserved exactly as Zora left it, the car debuts as the star exhibit of the Museum's 31st Anniversary celebration, honoring the "Godfather of the Corvette" and his lasting impact on America's sports car.

One of only 206 built, this 2012 Corvette ZR1 Centennial Edition celebrates Chevrolet's 100th anniversary in Carbon Flash Metallic with unique badging, suede-trimmed interior, and red accents. Powered by a 638-hp supercharged LS9 V8, it sprints to 60 mph in 3.5 seconds and tops out at 205 mph. Sold for \$96,500 USD!














## C8 Fire Risk Recall

It was reported last week that GM issued a voluntary recall for 2023 to 2026 model-year Corvette models over a fire risk while owners fuel up their sports car. The recall specifically applies to the 2023-2026 Z06 equipped with the 670-horsepower 5.5L V8 LT6 engine and the 2025-2026 ZR1 with its twin-turbo 5.5L V8 LT7 engine generating 1,064 horsepower.

According to campaign number 25V536 from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA), and GM recall number N252514930, the total number of affected Corvette units is 23,656.

The problem stems from the left-side radiator/fan combination found in the LT6 and LT7 engines. In rare cases, excess fuel spilled into the fuel-filler pocket can leak down on an ignition source. Naturally, this increases the risk of a fire.

GM's fix for affected Corvette Z06 and ZR1 models involves installing an insert or shield to divert fuel that may have spilled into the fuel-filler pocket away from any ignition source. The fuel-filler pocket is the only component affected by the recall, and every unit recalled will receive the fix.

GM provided the following statement to GM Authority:

"General Motors is voluntarily recalling model year 2023-2026 Chevrolet Corvette Z06s and 2025-2026 Corvette ZR1s in North America to resolve an excess fuel spillage issue during refueling. This is a rare occurrence, and malfunctioning filling station pumps appear to be a contributing factor. The safety of our customers is the highest priority for the entire GM team, and we're working to remedy this matter as quickly as possible."




