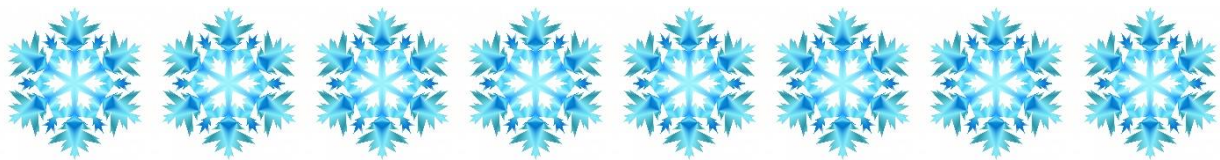

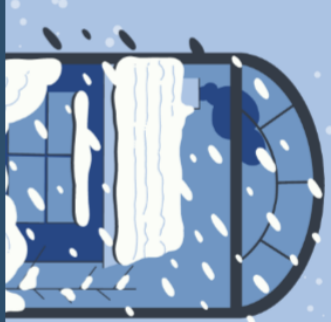

- The Program will begin Monday, January 17th and run through Friday, February 28th, 2022.
- You will officially be enrolled in the program the first time you turn in your reading.
- You can read books from the library, books you have at home, listen to audiobooks or read eBooks.
- The library has several new ways to record all the books you have read or listened to!!! To sign up and to turn in your reading for the program call the library at 785-448-3388. You can also email at garnettlibrarystaff@gmail.com or just drop by in person! You can use the Reader Zone App by simply downloading the App and entering program code cf893. Once the code is entered join the group Cabin Fever Reliever 2022.
- There will be weekly prize drawings. To be eligible, the previous week's reading must be turned in by Mondays at 3:00 pm.
- You can be entered into a drawing for an extra prize by completing a Bingo on our Bingo sheet.
- Read or listen to at least five books and you will be entered into the grand prize drawing.
- Take and Makes will be available each Friday throughout the program beginning Friday, January 21st.

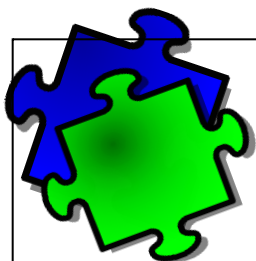

Therefore, the Garnett Public Library Friends of the Library will celebrate the occasion by selling pie at the library.
