My main concern in the first go of the Futurity was to make a smooth, solid run. I hadn't made a run on Weezy for the last couple of months (my boyfriend Cody Bauserman ran him at some of the other futurities, LG Pro Classic and the Diamonds and Dirt). The entire run felt really smooth. I wasn't expecting our time to be as fast as it was!

I approached the second go the same way. I didn't have any time in my head to beat and I didn't want to ride him any differently. He has a lot of run so I did my best to sit patiently and let him do his job.

We ended up winning the first go of the futurity on Saturday along with the Open (rollover), and we ran 2nd in the second go of the futurity on Sunday and 2nd in the Open (rollover). Those runs won us the Futurity average and the Open average.

Sharin Hall and the event staff at the JHM were incredibly nice. From the first time I was in the office to the last day, they were all very kind. It means a lot to me when people are genuinely nice.

DON'T JUDGE MY SOCKS was bred and raised by Beverly Weekly. We purchased him in the fall of his 2-year-old year (he was broke to ride when we bought him). Cody and I had both wanted to try a BHR Frenchies Socks and really liked the cross on paper (Dam - Judge Dixie x Judge Cash). We went to Southeastern Arena in Unadilla, GA for a couple of months that winter to get our 2yos (turning 3yos) started on the pattern. It was a great facility to use and it was a huge help for us to have a place like that to start them. That summer (3yo's now) I started hauling to local jackpots to expose him to as much as I could. He was very "looky" for a little while. Every little thing stood out to him and he took some extra time

to get his confidence. Then it sort of seemed like an overnight transition that he grew up on us. Now he is a confident individual; he doesn't let much bother him. I ran him in the Juvenile at OKC in December and we had sort of run into some bumps. Cody decided to ride him for a little while to help him get over the "speed jam" and he did well at both the LG Pro Classic in Kinder, LA and the Diamonds and Dirt in Waco, TX. Cody has so much experience and knowledge with young horses, it definitely helped Weezy through that little speed bump.

Preferences...

I ride Weezy in a Shiloh saddle, 5 Star pad, and usually a tie down and o-ring bit.

Training Tip...

I like my horses to know both an inside and an outside rein before doing much pattern work. I think you have to find a happy balance for each horse, (some have a lot of natural bend, some like to be stiff) but I think teaching them to give off of each pressure (inside and outside rein) helps keep one balanced.

Thank you to my Grandparents, Joe and Janet Bolin, of Rutland, Ohio for supporting me throughout most of my childhood and keeping me involved in the horses. My grandfather loves to get updates and emails from me. Mike and Debbie Jones were a large part of my teenage years and I can't thank them enough for the horses they put me on. Eileen Clark was a huge help to me and I will always be grateful for my lessons with her. And, I have to thank Cody for investing in the horses he purchased along with the irreplaceable help and advice he has given (and continues to give) me.
