





The season for bluebonnets in Texas only lasts about a month (roughly mid- March to mid-April), Texas:

Willow City Loop is located in the Fredericksburg area, about an hour and a half west of Austin. If you're looking for a scenic drive perfect for spotting bluebonnets in the Texas Hill Country, Willow City Loop is the place for you! If you keep driving onwards from Willow City Loop you'll reach the small town of Llano. With a population of under 4,000, it's a fairly small town but it's the perfect place for the wildflowers to come up every season. A large trail called <u>The Highland Lakes Bluebonnet Trail</u> spans multiple cities and it cuts through this part of town as well. Because this area is ever so slightly less known for bluebonnets than nearby Burnet you'll have a better chance of being able to enjoy the flowers and take photos


without as much of a crowd!
