

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**Ordinance O-2013-23**

**A ORDINANCE APPROVING THE VILLAGE'S PARTICIPATION IN A "PRE-TAX"  
CONTRIBUTION PLAN FOR THE OHIO POLICE AND FIRE PENSION FUND**

**WHEREAS**, The eligible employees of the Amelia Village Police Department participate in the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund ("OP&F"); and

**WHEREAS**, Council has previously adopted a pick-up of all of the ten percent (10%) mandatory contributions required under Section 742.31 of the Ohio Revised Code for participating employees of the Police Department who are members of the OP&F; and

**WHEREAS**, Council wishes to reaffirm, amend, and restate its prior resolution in order to continue the pick-up under the recently amended Section 742.31 of the Ohio Revised Code;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO:**

**SECTION I.** That effective as of July 15, 2013, Amelia Village has determined to continue to pick-up all of the ten and three-quarter percent (10.75%) of the mandatory contributions by the employees who are members of Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund through a payroll reduction.

**SECTION II.** That effective as of July 14, 2014, Amelia Village has determined to continue to pick-up all of the eleven and one-half percent (11.50%) of the mandatory contributions by the employees who are members of Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund through a payroll reduction.

**SECTION III.** That effective as of July 13, 2015, Amelia Village has determined to continue to pick-up all of the twelve and one-quarter percent (12.25%) of the mandatory contributions by the employees who are members of Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund through a payroll reduction.

**SECTION IV.** That said pick-up contributions paid through a payroll reduction, even though designated as employee contributions for state law purposes, are being paid by the Council in lieu of said contribution by the employee.

**SECTION V.** That said pick-up contribution will not be included in the gross income of the employees for tax reporting purposes, that is for federal or state income tax withholdings; until distributed from the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.

**SECTION VI.** That said employees shall not be entitled to any option of choosing to receive the contributed amounts directly instead of having them paid by the Village to the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.

**SECTION VII.** That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.

**SECTION VI.** Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

DERRICK CAMPBELL moved for the adoption of the Ordinance.

SUSAL ELLIOTT seconded the motion for adoption of the Ordinance.
