April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025

### **Attendance:**

### **Opening – Brian Boehm (present):**

- Brian Boehm called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Introduction of Officers

### **Secretary's Report – Steve Thurmond (present):**

- March minutes read and approved with no corrections.

### **Treasurer's Report – Bill Means (present):**

- Income for 1-1-2025 to 4-7-2025 was \$8,760.00,
  - Property taxes were paid which lowered the balance.
- Expenses were \$8,029.11
- Net Income of \$730.97
- Details of the treasurers report are available from Bill if anyone wants to see details.

### **Membership Report – Steve Close: (present):**

- Currently we have 66 regular members and 12 seniors for a total of 78.
  - 1 member became a senior last month
- Collected \$875 in dues.
- 9 dues reminders were sent out.
- No work credits applied in February.
- 2 first readings.
- Phill Grundberg who owns his own lawn care service, shoots pistol, sponsored by Shawn Konicki.
- Andrew Pewleczyk works at US Bank, shoots pistol and rifle, he and his father collect WWII era guns, sponsored by Brian Boehm
- 0 second readings.

### **Rifle Team – (Rifle chair position is vacant):**

- Rifle league is wrapping up, with John Lathrop running the league only. Other rifle chair duties have been vacant since fall. John was not present and no updates were reported.

- Target retravel and hanging (competitors don't hang or score their own targets in a rifle match)
- Competitor registration
- Target Scoring
- Match Director (Jon Speck)

Each member worked 12 hours a day including cleanup on Sunday plus 2 hours (sectionals) and 4 hours (JO match) Friday evening for setup.

### **Webmaster – Jon Speck (not present):**

- No one has stepped up to take the position after Jon advised the club that he is stepping down.

### **Rental Property – Tony Del Frate (not present):**

- Tennant is currently paid up as of April 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Several bills need to be submitted from Tony for repairs done to the rental.
- Tony is scheduling to have the septic tanks pumped out. This needs to be done approximately every other year to avoid issues.

## Match Director – Dora Potekin (present):

- April 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Southport hosted the Wisconsin Indoor Pistol Championships with 2 relays on Saturday and 2 relays on Sunday.
  - There were 23 shooters at \$45 per shooter for a total of \$1035
  - Dora reported results and images of results posted in the April minutes.
  - Expenses: snacks -\$25, pin invoice -\$77.50, still need to figure NRA and Wisconsin Force fees, medal and postage -100.00,
  - Dora estimated \$600 in profits from match
  - There was only one point difference between first and second place.
