### Thursday ♦ Travel Day

Today, we'll sit back and enjoy our drive to the Buckeye State of Ohio as we travel through the Keystone State of Pennsylvania. Lunch will be on your own en route. We'll arrive mid to late afternoon at the Drury Inn in Grove City, Ohio for our 2 night stay. Dinner is included at the hotel. Enjoy the evening on your own at the hotel. The hotel has an indoor pool and fitness room. (D)

### Friday ♦ Dayton, Ohio

We'll enjoy an included breakfast before departing the hotel for our visit to the National Museum of the United States Air Force. It is the official museum of the United States Air Force, located at the Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, northeast of Dayton, Ohio. The NMUSAF is the oldest and largest military aviation museum in the world, with more than 360 aircraft and missiles on display. This must-see experience will take you from the Wright Brothers first flight, through WWI, WWII, Korea, and Vietnam, to the experimental test planes of today. This awesome museum presents these extraordinary airplanes and the stories of some of those who built them and flew them. Dinner tonight is included at the hotel. You'll have the evening on your own to enjoy the pool, fitness room or just sit and relax with your fellow travelers and discuss your day at the museum.

### Saturday ♦ Somerset, PA

Following an included breakfast at the hotel, we will board the coach for our journey to Mill Run, PA. Lunch is on our own prior to our afternoon visit to Fallingwater, designed by America's most famous architect, Frank Lloyd Wright. Fallingwater, the private home constructed over a waterfall, instantly became famous when it was built in 1935, and today is a National Historic Landmark.

Fallingwater is among eight buildings designed by Frank Lloyd Wright that have been named UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Dinner is included before retiring for the evening at the Somerset Hampton Inn. (B, D)

### Sunday ♦ Travel Home

Following our included breakfast at the hotel, we will board the coach to visit the Flight 93 Memorial Chapel in Friedens, PA. The chapel is a fitting memorial and has become a sort of mini museum of Flight 93. It now has all sorts of items from families and visitors, including a model plane that was built by the flight engineer when he was nine. Out back is a 14-foot high memorial for the United Airlines flight crew that perished on this flight. Lunch is on your own en route home. Following our lunch

stop, we will return home with fond memories of our trip. (B)
