

WIREHAIRED DACHSHUND GROOMING CHART

MEDIUM

B
BLEND

Pull Fan Shape BETWEEN EYES (Remember Dachs should have very little stop so fill in to make it appear that way)

EYE BROWS - strip close to outside corner of eye - Comb forward & shape longer on inside corner - shorter on outside corner - Brush back and to the side.

USE Thinning Shears to straighten the ridges on each side of neck - After stripping

TAIL Full Robust

USE Thinning Shears to straighten after stripping to make Round.

Trim to a Point

Thinning shear to make clean lines after stripping

PET GROOMING

C Use # 10 blade on head and neck. Hair may need to be pulled from inside the ear canal in some dogs.

B Shape beard from outside corner of the eye to the corner of the mouth with a stripping knife (SHOW) or thinning shears. (PET)

The eyebrows are parted and are shaped with a stripping knife (SHOW) or thinning shears (PET)

M Use #9 or #7 blade on body.

GROOMING TIP FOR PETS

Comb with a fine flea comb daily to minimize shedding.

SHOW GROOMING

Strip the body 6 to 8 weeks before a show. (This varies with each individual dog) Strip the neck and head 2 to 3 weeks before a show. Strip dead hair from the ears making them smooth.

SAME FOR SHOW AND PET GROOMING

B BLEND furnishing with either a stripping knife (show) or thinning shears (pet) Round feet with scissors. Trim hair from the bottom of feet even with pads.

BATHE AND TRIM NAILS ON AT LEAST A MONTHLY BASIS.
