WALKING IN GOD'S WORD


We acknowledge that the Bible is God's truth and provides direction for our lives. Seeking biblical truth is vital, both in our church and in our personal devotions.


DAY 1: (Psalm 71) Luke 5:12-16

 By touching the man before He heals him, what is Jesus saying?


 When have you felt like an outcast like the leper?
How did Jesus "touch" you then? Did He use someone in the process?


DAY 2: (Psalm 72) Luke 5:17-26

 What new realm of Jesus' authority is demonstrated here?


 Who are you most like in this story and why?

DAY 3: (Psalm 73) Luke 7:1-10

 On what basis do the elders request Jesus' help? The Centurion?
How does this relate to Jesus' commandment?


 Does it make a practical difference whether you live by confidence in your goodness, or by trust in Christ's power? How does this show up, especially in a time of crisis?

DAY 4: (Psalm 74) 2 Kings 4:8-37 and Luke 7:11-17

 With 2 Kings 4:8-37 in mind, why does Jesus perform this miracle?
What does Jesus reveal about Himself?

 How does Jesus' love and authority make a difference in your life?

DAY 5: (Psalm 75) Luke 7:36-50

 What does Jesus see in this woman that Simon did not? How does this affect Jesus' actions toward her? What is Jesus' main concern? Peter's?

 In regard to relationships, are you a "big forgiver" or a "stingy one"?
