The fish were not biting as they are full of squid.

Steve decided to run to the West end of Santa Cruz Island which is a 1 ½ hour longer boat ride so our newly elected Charter master Ernie Branch was initiated with the challenge to notify everyone of the 3:00 am departure. This can prove to be difficult contacting people the last minute but it all worked out fine.

Steve and John arrived at the boat by 3:00 am and with bait already on board, we promptly left the dock. Crossing the channel was windless with only medium swells.

Not too much snoring in the bunk room so I got some sleep and it was a good ride.

getting in the Jackpot and setting up tackle to begin fishing.

Steve got on the bullhorn and asked if we wanted to fish shallow water or deep water Rock fish. We decided to fish shallow water and see what happens.

Our first stop toward the West end of Santa Cruz Island turned out to be a "Bummer" no bite and no fish. Steve announced that it'll probably get worse from here. Everyone was thinking another slow trip. Ugh.

As we got to the West end of Santa Cruz Island conditions were good with clean clear water. We started off slowly but at least some action. As we moved from spot to spot Steve metered fish and our catch rate got better and better. It didn't seem to matter what we used to get hook ups. We were using dropper loops, slider rigs or lead heads and we didn't know what we could catch. The key was to use light weight line and we would get a bite every cast. We caught Sugar Bass, Reds, Chucklehead, Ling Cod and other Rock Fish. It was excellent shallow water fishing. Everyone began filling their sacks with an assortment of fish.

The Total catch consisted of 1 Calico Bass, 5 Sheephead, 28 White Fish, 11 Ling Cod and 100 miscellaneous Rock Fish.

We caught many undersized Ling Cod that were successfully released and the hot fishermen for legal size Ling Cod were Gordon Chan and Gary Christopher with limits.
