

# RETAIL SHOPPING CENTER - VRP SITE

## Marietta, GA

## **Contaminants:**

PCE, TCE, vinyl chloride, cis-1,2-DCE

### **Treatment:**

N/A

### Site Status:

Active, No Listing pending

This site is a commercial shopping center which had a lease pending from a large retailer (Wal-Mart). Results from a Phase I/II investigation indicated the presence of tetrachloroethene (PCE) and other constituents present in the soil and groundwater attributed to an on-site dry cleaner. In addition, other detected contaminants were presumed to be from potential off-site sources, such as an adjacent LUST site and RCRA generator.

In 2012, Envirorisk was contracted to prepare the application for the Voluntary Remediation Program (VRP) and conduct subsequent investigations. Research of background information revealed that the onsite cleaners was a pick-up/drop-off facility only, and an adjacent property formerly operated as a dry cleaning facility. Through the installation of several borings and monitoring wells and a groundwater flow evaluation, Envirorisk was able to demonstrate that the contamination was from an off-site source.

EPD concurred with the findings, and released the Client from further investigations required under the VRP. The site is currently pending a No Listing.
