Love one another as I have loved you. Do not be selfish with your time, rather demonstrate to them how much you love and respect them by being prompt on the walkie, and eager to see them move on and have a productive night. You must learn My priorities, what is important to Me to do first. Is someone in pain? Is there an accident? Is someone exhausted or sick? Is it a matter of feeding souls?
