










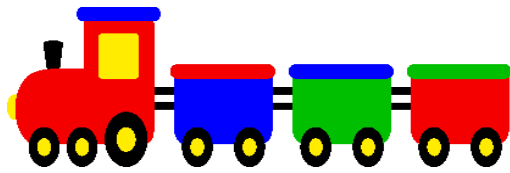


April Library Reading Train Challenge (ages 3-6)
