Anointing of the Sick: World Day of the Sick, February 11, 2023 "Take Care of Him"

Illness is part of our human condition. Yet, if it is experienced in isolation without care or compassion, it can become inhumane. When we travel with others, someone may get sick, injured, or need to stop to rest. When this happens, this is when we see how we are traveling together. Are we truly traveling as a companion or merely traveling looking out for ourselves and leaving others to "make do"?
