

MOTION TO DISQUALIFY AS PROSECUTING ATTORNEY

Comes Larry K. Cook, Prosecuting Attorney from the Seventeenth-West Judicial District and for his Motion to Disqualify, states:

- That Larry Cook is the duly elected and authorized
 Prosecuting Attorney for the Seventeenth-West Judicial
 District which Lonoke County is a part.
- That the Prosecuting Attorney's office has filed two counts of Rape, Class Y felonies, against the defendant.
- 3. That the Prosecuting Attorney's office is reviewing additional information concerning potential additional charges to be filed against the defendant.
- 4. That the Prosecuting Attorney's office and his staff may appear to have a potential conflict because the defendant's father was a former Circuit Chancery Judge in this jurisdiction.
- 5. In order to avoid even the appearance of potential conflict, and to protect the interest of justice and to further foster confidence in the judicial system, the

Prosecuting Attorney requests that he and his entire staff disqualify and that the Court appoint a Special Prosecutor for this cause of action only and any causes of action which may arise against the defendant, Charles Walls, III, but to no other individuals.

WHEREFORE, the Prosecuting Attorney for the Seventeenth-West Judicial District prays that the Court appoint a special prosecutor for this cause of action only and for all other proper relief.
