It took many difficult and "lively" meetings to reach consensus on our history, our present, and our future.

Thanks to all of you who filled out a survey, chose Leadership Competencies, or participated in interviews with the Team. Your opinions and comments helped the Team prepare the Study, and will help the PNC develop the on-line document describing Mars Church.

At this writing, I have been your pastor for just over sixteen months. Some have expressed frustration at the pace of the Interim Process. It has indeed been a long and sometimes difficult journey, but as a community of faith, we had many issues to resolve before we were ready to elect the PNC. - Preschool having problems with their flooring, they will pay any costs to repair/replace

Offerings for June have declined from the weekly rates of the first five months of this year, while our spending rates have not declined. Please remember to submit your offerings each week. Thank You


