



Teams are limited to SF residents only with few exceptions based on league and city rules. Proof of residency is required for all players at all levels in order to qualify. ### IFC and SCORES join forces to get beyond pay-to-play youth soccer

For the past 18 years, America SCORES Bay Area has offered a soccer/academics hybrid to a growing number of after-school programs in San Francisco. Today, SCORES is present in about half the public schools in the city, serving about 1,100 youngsters.

For the past 18 months, Independent FC (IFC) has offered club-based soccer opportunities on an innovative donation-based model, growing to 20 current teams serving 300 boys and girls.

Now the two have joined forces to offer full access to organized soccer in San Francisco at all levels for all children by eliminating restrictive price barriers to the game.

The goal is to give San Francisco youth a soccer a real competitive alternative where money doesn't matter – just commitment to the team and ambition to continuously improve.

Who is eligible?

Independent FC is open to boys and girls ages 8-18 who reside in San Francisco or are eligible to attend San Francisco public schools. The club fields teams at recreational; local competitive and travel leagues.

### What does IFC cost?

Zero. IFC does not charge any fee to play for one of our teams. We ask each family to cover the cost of playing kits (about \$90 every two years) and the pro-rated cost of league and tournament registrations (\$200-500 per year). But for families for families who request financial assistance, we raise money through donations to help defray these costs. Teams play in at least the Fall and Spring seasons. Winter futsal leagues and tournaments are also be available on a team-by-team basis.

### Is IFC a low-income club?

Absolutely not. The biggest problem with youth soccer in San Francisco is segregation. Those who can afford it, play with expensive clubs that only draw players from affluent families. Those who can't afford it mostly do not play or play on underfunded teams with no professional coaching. That has to change for San Francisco soccer to rise above the "mediocre", as it has been described in print media. Great youth soccer requires full desegregation of the game, achieved only by eliminating all financial barriers.

### What is IFC's coaching approach?

The one-coach, one-team model does not foster strong development. Independent FC's children receive training from a community of coaches including paid professional coaches, college and high-school level players who serve as assistants and well-trained volunteers (often a team parent).

### How does IFC differ from other clubs?

In many ways listed above. Here are some more:

- IFC's goal is to build a soccer community, balancing diversity, equity and soccer excellence;
- · IFC does not contractually bind a player to the club or team;
- IFC will never force a family to pay a fee in order to release a player to another club or team;
- IFC competes on equal footing against other local clubs and teams, and, while entirely independent, also collaborates with other clubs on behalf of our players and families.

However, if a player is misbehaving or acting in a manner that seriously and negatively impacts the overall experience for his teammates, the coach may withhold the player from participating further in a game.
- Competitive Soccer (Bronze/Silver) while there are no minimum playing time rules set by playing leagues, our coaches will always give playing time to all players who are attending training sessions and working diligently to improve themselves and make a positive impact on the team. Typically, all players should expect to play a minimum of 1/3 to 1/2 of a game.
- Competitive Soccer (Gold/Premier) our most competitive teams may utilize more variable playing time tactics based on the significance of each game. However, it is extremely rare to have any player not play in a game.
