Harold E. Plester, 74, of Harbor Beach, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, Aug. 5, 2003, at Harbor Beach Community Hospital. Born in Harbor Beach on Feb. 16, 1929, he was the son of the late Charles and Amelia (Winkel) Plester. Harold was a veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving in the U.S. Navy for three years.
