- 3. The winner will be required to attend the 2025 fair (June 25th 29th 2025) and attend the 2025 coronation. All contestants are strongly encouraged to attend Dairylicious Days, along with other community events, to help promote themselves as contestants and the fair. Specific duties may be assigned to the winner at events he or she attends.
- 4. The winner is encouraged to represent The Marquette County Fair at surrounding community festivals. Details about this portion will be given out to the contestant after his/ her application is received by the program director.
- 5. Should the winner not be able to fulfill his/her obligations, the first runner-up will assume the duties of the Marquette County Jr Fairest of the Fair.
- 6. The winner is required to assist during events at the Marquette County Fair or any events that they are not involved in. The 2025 Marquette County Fair will be held on June 24th through June 29th, 2025.
- 7. The contestants must present themselves in an appropriate manner at all times when representing the fair. This includes appropriate business casual dress (no ripped jeans, short shorts, low cut tops, etc), no smoking, alcohol, tobacco or drug use, and limited cell phone use.
