What can I plant??**

- ❖ **Pansies, Snapdragons, & petunias are very cold hardy. They are safe to put out early. The temperatures actually make them stronger, nicer plants.**
- ❖ **Perennials can go out any time. Make sure that they have been hardened off if it is still cold outside. Hardening off means that they should be climatized to the weather outside before you plant them.**
- ❖ **These vegetables are safe to plant in March & April. Or if weather permits, even in February for some varieties. These Vegetables actually prefer the cooler weather.**
