

MSMS saves Michigan Physicians \$2,000,000+

BCBSM cancels modifier 25 payment adjustment for evaluation and management services



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When the Michigan State Medical Society (MSMS) learned Blue Cross Blue Shield of Michigan (BCBSM) was going to pay evaluation and management (E&M) services billed with modifier 25 at 80 percent, MSMS took action.

During several conversations with BCBSM, MSMS provided tangible evidence proving there was no overlap in services when an E&M is billed with office procedures. As a result, BCBSM canceled the implementation of the policy, restoring it back to 100 percent and saving Michigan physicians more than \$2 million.

"This is a tangible benefit for MSMS members," said MSMS President Betty S. Chu, MD, MBA. "Without MSMS at the table representing Michigan physicians, we would've lost more than \$2 million in care services. I strongly urge all Michigan physicians to join MSMS because we need them to be our voice, tell our story and support us."
