Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll, West District Commissioner, Kyle White, East District Commissioner, Chet Owen and County Clerk, Melissa Meek.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll welcomed those in attendance and led all in prayer. The Pledge of Allegiance was then recited by all in attendance.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve today's agenda with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to approve the minutes from the July 5th meeting with East District Commissioner, Chet Owen making the second. All in favor. Motion carried.

Collector/Treasurer Jessica Lee met with the Commission to get their approval to remove taxes from the tax books for a parcel that has been on there for over 20 years with no payment. This parcel is in Cameron between MODOT and the car wash. It is not usable land and is basically a ditch. The Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carroll made the motion to grant the Collector's request with West District Commissioner, Kyle White making the second. All in favor, White-aye, Owen-aye, and Carroll-aye. Motion carried 3-0. Please note the property is still in the name of FRIPCO with the owner being Hanson. If the owner ever comes back into DeKalb County, they will be required to pay all back taxes associated with this property.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised that Ted & Gala Ellis would be resigning their positions at the end of the month. The Commission wishes them both the best of luck in their next adventure.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek presented the sales tax reports to the Commission and advised that the Wayfair monies were included in our Use Tax. Also presented were fund balances, Sunset rent and the County's current valuation.

Road & Bridge Supervisor, Bill Gray met with the Commission to discuss brush letters, equipment repairs, fuel and issues around the County. Concerns were of a patron parking equipment in the right of way in Adams Township. The Sheriff has been notified and will contact the landowner. A patron stopped in concerning brush and he was advised that landowner would be getting a brush letter notice. Just a reminder that now only 1 letter will be sent to patrons needing to cut brush, but patrons will have 6 months to get the removal completed.

Gabe DeShon of Washington Township stopped by to deliver brush complaints.

Garry McFee of Howe & Company stopped by to see if the County needed anything from his Company.

The Commission broke at noon to attend a meeting in Cameron concerning DDRJ (Daviess DeKalb Regional Jail). Due to recent court rulings, funding is a concern at the jail.

September 21st is the next meeting of the NW Commissioner's which will be held in Grundy County.

With no other business before the Commission, West District Commissioner, Kyle White made the motion to adjourn until July 18, 2023. East District Commissioner, Chet Owen made the second to adjourn. All in favor. Motion carried.
