AFTER SCHOOL K-12 PROGRAM

Our After School Program offers many different courses in Italian Geography, History, Italian Literature, and Language to children of native Italians who live in Pittsburgh, which follow the Italian Curriculum from Schools in Italy. We also offer Italian Language courses to non native speakers, who desire to learn Italian from the Beginning Level 1 to Beginner Level 2. In addition to language courses, we also offer Cultural Courses on Italian Dance, Art History, Italian music, Theatre, and Cooking Courses. Classes are **Monday through Friday between 3:30pm-6:30pm, Sat 10am-12 (See the Time Chart for all the different course time options)**

Course Descriptions:

Courses for Native Italian Children:

- **The Language Courses for Italian Natives** are all taught by Native Italian Educators, who follow the Curriculum from Italy, through the use of the Book *Fanta Parole*, and other materials. The Language Courses go above and beyond what is expected of Native children Speakers, focusing on Important Grammar Points, Language and Sentence Structure, Reading and Writing, and many other topics: e.g. Math, Technology, some Small readings, and learning how to write in Italian. Each level is age appropriate and follows the School ages of the Children.
- **The Geography and History Courses for Italian Natives** are all taught in Italian by Native Italian Educators, who follow the Curriculum from Italy, and use of the books *Fanta Parole Geography and History*, as well as, other texts for 4/5. This course is meant to develop a better understanding of the Italian and European Geography as well as the fundamentals of their histories.
- **The Italian Literature Courses for Italian Natives** are all taught in Italian by Native Italian Educators, who follow the Curriculum from Italy, and use of the books *Fanta Parole Literature* and other texts selected by the Instructor. This course will not only discuss Italian Literature in detail, but will allow students to create sentence structure and to learn how to create their own stories (age appropriate levels).

Language Courses for Non Natives:

- **The Language Courses for non-native speakers** are meant for those students who are interested in learning Italian, but who have not ever studied the language before, and who do not speak it at home. All Courses are taught by Professional Educators and follow La Scuola d'Italia Galileo Galilei's unique curriculum, educational materials and approaches designed by its Executive Director and staff. The language courses are an excellent, fun, and exciting way for your children to learn Italian. The courses are all interactive, with a mix of conversation, grammar, art, math, allowing students to learn and be creative at the same time. Your children are guaranteed to learn Italian in these classes!
- **Beginner Italian Level 1** is an introduction to the Italian Language, through the use of imagery, pictures, games, and lots of interactive and educational activities that focus on colors, forms, vocabulary, language, and sentence structure, depending upon the age of the students. All students will learn to speak Italian, read Italian, and eventually write in Italian (again age appropriate). All materials and educational activities are provided by La Scuola GG and offers so much more for the kids to help them learn Italian. You will be amazed by how quickly they will learn! *(The Curriculum is developed by our Executive Director who has 13 years of teaching experience, a teaching Certificate from the Masters Program at the University of Pittsburgh) and lots of success in teaching children Italian!*
- **Beginner Italian Level 2** is a continuation of level 1, again focusing on interactive and educational activities specifically developed for children to give them a head start in learning Italian quickly and easily. This level develops and builds student's vocabulary, and competency in grammar (age appropriate), sentence structure, reading and writing (age appropriate). All students will learn to speak, to read, and to write in Italian, in a fun, easy, and exciting way! *(The Curriculum is developed by our Executive Director who has 13 years of teaching experience, a teaching Certificate from the Masters Program at the University of Pittsburgh) and lots of success in teaching children Italian!*

AFTER SCHOOL K-12 PROGRAM (Continued)

Cultural Courses:

- **Italian Dance** is a course where our Instructors will teach our students Traditional Italian Dances.
- **Art Studio and Art History** is an art course, structured for k-12 students, that allows students not only to learn about the famous Italian Artists, but to also practice their techniques and to learn how to sculpt and paint like Michelangelo, Raffaello, Leonardo da Vinci, and so many others.
- **Giro d'Italia: Language, Art, Cooking, History (New)** is a course structured to teach a little bit of Italian language, art and art history, cooking, gardening, culture, and history. A nice mix of all of the cultural aspects of Italy, all in one!
- **Italian Music** is a course that focuses on Italian Music (age appropriate) for both children and adolescents who want to learn more about Italian Culture, Language, and Music, through the study of Music.
- **Italian Theatre** is a course structured for ages 7 and up that not only teaches Italian Language through theatre, but also gives students a chance to perform on stage, and learn more about Italian Theatre, *Commedia dell'arte* and so much more!
- **Cooking Courses** is structured for children ages 7 and up who want to learn more about Italian homemade cooking, including *primi piatti* (first course), *secondi piatti* (second course), side dishes, and *dolci* (sweets/desserts) with an Italian Native expert cook!

ADULT PROGRAM

Our Adult Program is meant for Adults who want to continue with their education, and who want to learn more about the Italian language, History, and Culture. It offers a range of courses for different Levels of Italian, as well as, several cultural courses, that explore Italy's History, Culture, and everything beautiful about being Italian...

ADULT PROGRAM (Continued): If you are an adult interested in learning or improving your Italian speaking skills, these courses are for you!

Course Descriptions:

Language Courses:

- **Travel Course Beginner Level 1** is a course meant for those who would like to study the necessities for their trip to Italy. This course does not teach you to speak Italian fluently, but rather it takes you through the most important words and phrases, items and cultural facts and information that are very important to know before travelling to Italy.
- **Travel Course Advanced Beginner Level 2** is a course meant for those who have already taken the Level 1 course and would like a continuation, to become more proficient and semi-fluent, before travelling to Italy. This course does not teach you to speak Italian fluently, but rather it gives you even more exposure to the most important words and phrases, gestures, cultural information, and so much more, before travelling to Italy.
- **Beginner Italian Level 1** is meant for those adults who have never studied Italian before, but would really like to learn it. This course is structured to take you through the basics of the Italian Language- Vocabulary, Grammar, Pronunciation- with lots of conversation. This course offers an interactive way to learn Italian, and uses many different methodologies that are proven to work. So even if you have given up on learning Italian, this class is for you!
- **Advanced Beginner Italian level 2** is the second level, a continuation of Beginner level 1. This course will take you through to the next level of Italian Grammar, Vocabulary, Sentence Structure, Conversation, and offers a great opportunity to expand on your Italian language and Cultural knowledge.

ADULT PROGRAM (Continued)

Course Descriptions:

Language Courses (cont):

- **Intermediate Italian Level 3** is a semi-advanced course in which students are expected to be able to converse a fair amount in Italian. In this course, there is a deeper study of the Italian Grammar, a review of the *Passato Prossimo* and *Imperfetto*, with a complete study of the more advanced grammar points, all the way up to the *Congiuntivo*. There is also a comprehensive study of vocabulary with lots of different cultural points that are often discussed. This course is very conversational, but also focuses on reading and writing. You will definitely improve your Italian language skills in this course!
- **Advanced Italian Level 4** is an advanced course where students are expected to be able to converse quite well in Italian. In this course, there is a deeper study of Italian Grammar and a much more in depth review of the different forms of the *Congiuntivo* and all other grammar points, with a review of the prepositions, phrases (“Modi di Dire”) and much more in Italian. This course is very conversational, and focuses on reading and discussing texts. You will definitely improve your Italian language skills in this course!
- **Advanced Conversational Italian Level 5** is a conversational course, meant for those who have a relatively good understanding of the Italian Language and Grammar, but would like to expand their knowledge through the study of current events, and cultural points, through readings, articles, and lots of different materials, that will allow you to discuss opinions, ideas, thoughts and beliefs in Italian like a real Italian! This course is conversational, that will help you to improve your language skills, but it is also fun, and full of interesting facts and articles to read!

Cultural Courses:

- **Italian Dance** is a course where our students have the ability to learn traditional Italian Dance from our instructor.
- **Art History** is a course offered to adults, who want to expand their knowledge on Italian Art History, through the study of the ages. This course takes students through the most important time periods in Italian Art History, discussing the beginnings with Giotto, to the 13th and 14th centuries, Neoclassicism, Baroque, all the way through the Greats of the Renaissance to today! If you love Italian Art and History, you will love this course! This course is taught in English with a little Italian by our Art History Instructor who holds an M.A. in this field.
- **Italian Film** is a course that takes you on a journey through time and exposes you to Italy, its Culture, and its Cinema analyzing and studying the best *Cinema Italiano* through the years.
- **Italian Music (in Italian)** is an in-depth study of the Italian Language through the use of Italian Music. Not only will it cover grammar and syntax, but also the history and the cultural relevance of the music. In this course, students will explore all of the different eras of Italian Music, from the 40’s until today, how it has affected or changed Italian Culture, and how it has helped to make Italy and Italians what they are today. Music has played a significant role in Italian Culture and has changed the language, the way Italian see the world, and the way the world sees Italians.
- **Italian Music (in English, music in Italian)** is an in-depth study of the Italian Language through the use of Italian Music. Not only will it cover grammar and syntax, but also the history and the cultural relevance of the music. In this course, students will explore all of the different eras of Italian Music from the 40s until today, how it has affected or changed Italian Culture, and how it has helped to make Italy and Italians what they are today. Music has played a significant role in Italian Culture and has changed the language, the way Italian see the world, and the way the world sees Italians. **(No prior knowledge of Italian is required)**

- **Italian Vulgare** is a course meant for those students who want to study the basics of Italian Vulgare. This course not only discusses swear words in Italian, but goes much deeper into the study of the Italian culture, through the study of Gestures, Compliments, Insults, dialects, and so much more! If you want to learn how to speak like a real Italian, you must take this course! **(No prior knowledge of Italian is required)**
- **Cooking Course** is a course structured around *La Cucina Italiana*. It is a great way to learn how to cook like modern Italians. Each class will discuss a different Italian region, and a different cooking style. You will learn not only how to make great meals, and wonderful desserts, but also about Italian Culture, History, and Geography by Cooking! **(No prior knowledge of Italian is required) CURRENTLY OFFERED ONLY IN THE SPRING 2016-2017**

PRIVATE GROUP PROGRAM

The Private Group Program is set up for all ages, adults to K-12 (native and non native). You choose your group and the location, and we send a teacher to teach you or your children at the level of your desire. You and the other students split the cost, as though it was a real class. You decide to cancel if students cannot attend. You are in charge of the group and we can set up total costs per semester, like a real course, or lesson by lesson, as though they are private lessons, so if a class is cancelled, you don't pay anything. *(See Adult course descriptions and K-12 native and non-native course descriptions to understand better the structure of these courses)*

Course Descriptions:

Language Courses for families:

- **Travel Course Beginner Level 1** is a course meant for those who know very little to no Italian, but would like to learn the basics before travelling to Italy. This course is meant for families that would like to study together (all ages 7 and older). This course offers lots of great cultural information, too, giving you everything that you will need to know before travelling to Italy.
- **Travel Course Advanced Beginner Level 2** is a course meant for those who have already taken the Level 1 course and would like a continuation, to become more proficient and semi-fluent with deeper knowledge and understanding of Italian, before travelling to Italy. This course is meant for families (all ages 7 and older), and takes you again through the most important words and phrases, gestures, cultural information, and so much more, before travelling to Italy.
- **Beginner Italian Level 1** is a course meant for all family members (children 7 and older) who would like to study and to learn the Italian Language together. This course is an expansion of the beginner courses, teaching the basics in vocabulary, grammar, and conversation. This course will teach you Italian, with a homey atmosphere full of families, who want to learn together!

Language Courses for families (continued):

- **Advanced Beginner Italian Level 2** is the second level course, meant for families (children ages 7 and older) who would like to improve their Italian Language skills, as they continue on, learning Italian, expanding on the basics of vocabulary, grammar, and conversational Italian, with lots of interactive activities. What a great way to learn Italian in a comfortable home atmosphere full of families, who want to learn together!

Course Descriptions:

English Language Courses:

- **Beginner English Level 1** is a course that offers beginner level English for those who have little or no prior knowledge of English or *Pittsburghese*. We help with pronunciation, and will give you a better foundation to be able to communicate with other Americans in Pittsburgh.
- **Advanced beginner Level 2** is a course meant for those who have studied some English prior to coming to the U.S., but still have difficulty with their English skills and would like to improve their pronunciation as well as their comprehension and ability to speak *Pittsburghese*.
- **Intermediate Level 3** is a course for more advanced students who would like to practice and acquire the higher levels of grammar, speaking, as well as improve their comprehension and ability to understand the *Pittsburghese* accent.
- **Advanced Level 4** is a course meant for students who have a better understanding of English grammar, but would like to improve their speaking and comprehension skills, as well as the *Pittsburghese* language.
- **Advanced Conversation Level 5** is a course meant for those who would like to improve and to perfect their comprehension, grammar, and pronunciation through conversation and educational activities that will allow them to perfect their English skills at a more Native Level.

For the purposes of the Terms and Conditions, "force majeure" shall contemplate, but without limitation, Acts of God, explosions, lightning, fire, floods, earthquakes, tornados, hurricanes, blizzards, inclement weather, severe weather, natural disasters, epidemics, strikes, lockouts, or other industrial disturbances, riots, acts of a public enemy, wars, acts of civil unrest or disturbances, blockades, accidents or repairs to machinery or pipes, delays of carriers, embargoes, acts of public officials, and any other act or cause of whatever kind or character so long as the aforesaid are not the result of a Party's conduct or a Party is not able to overcome the force majeure by virtue of due diligence.
- 42. MEDIATION.** You agree and acknowledge that every dispute or difference that arises between us in connection with the Terms and Conditions first shall be settled by a meeting between us in which we attempt to resolve the dispute in a good faith manner. We must attempt to meet together as soon as reasonably practical. If we cannot resolve our dispute after conferring in good faith, either you or us may require the other to submit the matter to non-binding mediation, utilizing the services of an impartial, professional mediator approved by both of us. Such mediation shall occur as soon as reasonably practical, and neither you nor us unreasonably shall withhold our consent to the appointment of the mediator. In the event that we cannot agree on such a mediator, we shall retain one who is affiliated with the Mediation Counsel of Western Pennsylvania and we shall ask that the mediator be randomly assigned. We shall be responsible for payment of the costs and the expenses of the mediation in equal proportions; however, either party shall be entitled to advance the costs for the other party and to receive reimbursement for the same.
- 43. REGULATIONS, RULES, AND CODES.** You agree to abide by all rules, regulations, and codes of conduct that the facility in which you attend your Educational Activity has in effect at the time of your registration or puts into effect during your Enrollment. We reserve the right to terminate your Enrollment immediately without receipt of any refunds or credits in the event that you fail to observe and to respect the same.
- 44. PROMOTIONS.** In the event that we offer any promotions for our Educational Activities, you cannot combine more than two (2) promotions at one (1) time and the total discount for your promotions cannot exceed more than thirty percent (30%). If you already have used two (2) promotions in the past, you cannot use any additional promotions in the future for yourself. Any promotional offers from us have no commercial value, and you shall not receive the value of promotion in the event that you are entitled to receive a refund or a credit pursuant to the provisions herein.
