






Yet we confess that we have not always honored Your gifts.


We have neglected our responsibilities toward the earth, toward one another, and even toward our own bodies, which Your word calls temples of the Holy Spirit.

We pray in the mighty and holy name of Jesus Christ, our Lord. Amen.





