HOLIDAY BAZAAR


We will be having our Annual Holiday Bazaar on Sunday, November 2 - 9 am to 3 pm.

The Aerie By-Laws and House Rules Committee met in October regarding changes to be made to the Aerie By-Laws and House Rules.

The forms to use for Aerie members to suggest changes are available at the Planning Calander in the Aerie entrance/lobby area The committee requests that all submissions be in the hands of the committee before the first reading on November 12. The first and second readings of any By-Law or House Rule changes will be made at the regularly scheduled Aerie meetings in November. The third and final reading and final voting will be at the first regular Aerie meeting on December 10. In voting on proposed changes, a two thirds majority of all members present at that meeting voting in the affirmative is required for any change to be approved.
