

ORDINANCE NO. 1997- 6

Synopsis: Amendment to Building Code Ordinance to Require all Structures to Have a Minimum of Two (2) Points of Ingress and Egress

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the Town of Cloverdale, upon hearing a request from the Fire Department for all newly built structures to have a minimum of two (2) points of ingress and egress; and,


WHEREAS, the Plan Commission having discussed the merits of such request and having made a favorable recommendation to the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council's interest in protecting the citizens of Cloverdale is a paramount interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town of Cloverdale hereby adopts the following amendment to the Building Code Ordinance:


Any structures that are built, after the passage of this Ordinance, for human occupancy in the Town of Cloverdale, shall be required to have a minimum of two separate points of ingress and egress. Said points must be a minimum of 32" wide and 6'8" high.
