

Summer Camp Rules and Regulations

All Campers must be at least 4 years old and must be FULLY POTTY TRAINED. They must come to the Masjid in proper Islamic clothing with head cover. Students should bring proper change of clothing with proper shoes for the Field Trips. Campers must follow Sunnah and pray all the Salats with Jamaat.

***Girls must wear an abaya (Burqa) or appropriate clothing with a Hijab (head scarf)**

- Students are not allowed to wear inappropriate clothing; Pajamas, T-Shirts, or any clothing that depicts living things i.e. Images of humans, animals or dragons etc. **NO SHORTS!** Student may not be allowed to attend the Camp that day if he is inappropriately dressed.
- Parents MUST provide a latest Medical exam report (no later than 6 months) of the applicant.
- All Campers must comply with the Rules and Regulations of the Program.
- All Campers MUST always follow directions from IDE Staff, especially on Field trips.
- Any student who disrespects a teacher or any of the staff members, or who fights with any other students, or uses vulgar language, may be EXPELLED IMMEDIATELY.
- Students are not allowed to have any Electronics devices with them. Any devices found with the students will be taken away and kept until the parents retrieve it.
- Students are only allowed to watch educational TV programs on a very limited basis; they are NOT to play with video games that are contrary to Islamic education. Parents are strongly urged to keep their kids away from ALL forms of media that is contrary to Islamic education.
- Summer Camp Program for ages 4-5 will be held Monday through Thursday, all other ages will include Friday. Hours: 9:00AM to 2:00PM, (ALL kids 7 and under MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR APPROVED GUARDIAN. Field trips pick up maybe be approximately 3:00PM) Insha'Allah.
- A fee of **\$400 for New Campers** and **\$300.00** per child for return campers and Maktab students (sibling discounts available) is expected to be PAID IN FULL with this application.
- The Parents or Guardians of the Pledging Students hereby assume Financial and Legal responsibility in case the Student willfully damages School or Private Property or harms a person while on or about School premises. They also acknowledge that they DO NOT and WILL NOT hold Iqra Darul Ehsan Inc. responsible for the above-mentioned irresponsible action of Student. IDE reserves the right to expel any student/camper without notice.
