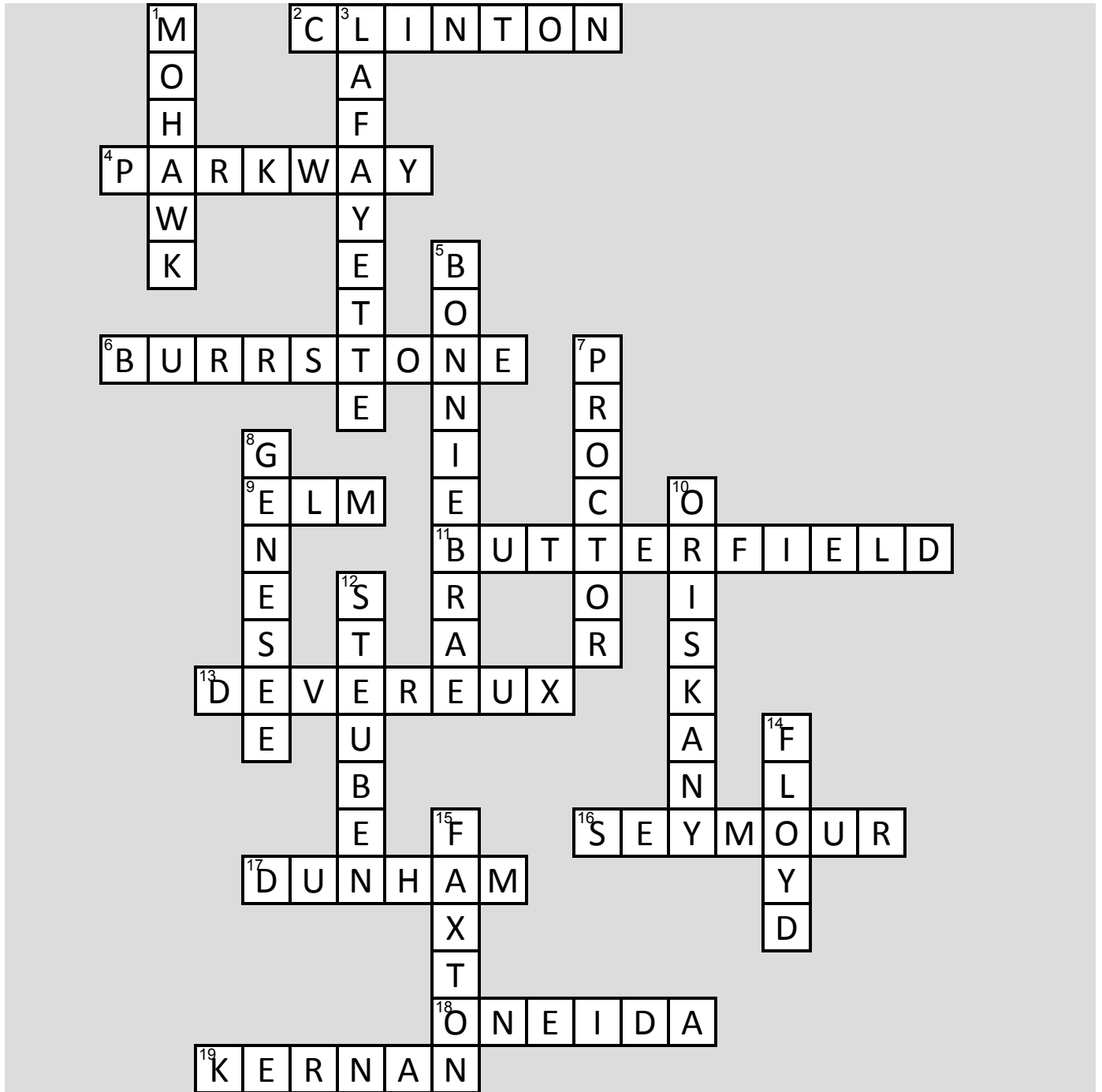


Utica Street Names

- 2 Street named for a governor of New York who was known as "the father of the Erie Canal."
- 4 This street that has a golf course, a ski slope and a zoo.
- 6 This street had a factory that manufactured stones used for grinding grain and was named for that stone.
- 9 Street named for trees which once graced the area but were lost to disease.
- 11 Street named for the founder of American Express Company and owner of a downtown hotel.
- 13 Street named for Irish immigrant brothers who established St. John's Catholic Church.
- 16 Street named for man who served as both mayor of Utica and governor of New York
- 17 Street named for an editor of the Utica Daily Press who has a statue on the Parkway
- 18 Street named for the Native American tribe that once occupied land that became Utica
- 19 Street named for the Utican who became the first Catholic senator from the state of New York.

Down

- 1 Street that bears the same name as the river that runs through the city.
- 3 Street named for Frenchman who served under George Washington in the Revolutionary War.
- 5 This street has a Scottish name which means "pretty hillside."
- 7 Street named for the family who donated land for city parks.
- 8 Utica's main street
- 10 Street named for a Revolutionary War battle
- 12 Street named for the German who trained troops during the Revolutionary War.
- 14 Street named for a signer of the Declaration of Independence who lived in Westernville.
- 15 Street named for prominent Utican who founded a hospital
