

AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 80.240 REVISED
STATUTES OF MISSOURI 1994, AS AMENDED, PROVIDING
FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF CERTAIN VILLAGE OFFICIALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
INNSBROOK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One.

All offices of the Village set forth in Section 80.240 Revised Statutes of Missouri, other than the Board of Trustees, shall be appointed offices.

Section Two.

Unless otherwise prescribed by statute or ordinance, the term of appointment for all such appointed officials shall be for an indefinite time not to exceed four (4) years or until removed at will by the Chairman with the consent of the Board of Trustees, or by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members of the Board of Trustees.


Section Three.

Unless hereinafter provided or otherwise required by law, residence in the Village shall not be required for any appointed office, but may be a factor considered in such appointment.

Section Four.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
