

What is the Average Cost of a Bathroom Remodel?

Homeowners have many options when it comes to bathroom remodels and the total cost depends on style and budget. The **average small to medium sized bathroom remodel costs \$18,348-\$31,800+**, and most homeowners don't realize the costs involved until they start putting together pricing information for replacement or changes to the bathroom. Smaller bathrooms can cost less depending upon the type of remodel. If you are only replacing countertops, fixtures, paint and flooring the average would be anywhere from \$10,500-\$17,500 depending upon the size and type of selections used. If you are replacing a fiberglass shower surround with a tiled shower, new fixtures and glass doors the cost averages \$9,000-\$13,000+ just for this part of a renovation. On the other end of the spectrum, you could spend \$30,000 to more than \$45,000+ to really upgrade and do things like remove a garden tub, add a larger tiled shower, add more cabinet/countertop space, redoing flooring and adding new vanities, countertops and faucets which will be somewhere in this price range depending upon what selections you make. If you are looking for an "aging in place" bathroom design, removing a tub surround to put in a walk-in shower the cost can be higher for this type of redesign work. In addition all the tile work if you are removing shower inserts and putting in glass shower doors, new vanities, new countertops, plumbing and lighting you can expect to pay well into \$30k plus for a good renovation.

Bathroom remodels provide some of the highest resale returns as a home improvement project. However, it is not by any means cheap, and it can take up to 3 weeks or more for the work to get done. Therefore it is essential to gather and plan your bathroom remodeling ideas ahead of time for the room and then find the right remodeling contractor for the job. Estimating Bathroom Remodel Costs

Determining your budget could be tricky when planning your renovation. A large factor in determining cost will be the size of your bathroom, ranging from small to medium or master bathroom size. The fixtures you will need to fit in your bathroom will range in price depending on their size. The list of features involved in remodeling a bathroom can include elements like faucets and fixtures, floor plan changes, new showers or baths, new flooring, countertops, cabinets and lighting. You need to determine if you are providing the materials or having your contractor get and install everything. The downsides of providing your own materials are you won't have access to wholesale pricing, it is hard to



coordinate finding all the items necessary to carry out your remodel and mainly because unless you are doing this yourself it is difficult to find a skilled handyman who knows how to install all of the elements required. This long list comes with a lot of different prices and options to compare before choosing what to have for your bath remodel. The suggestion from Houzz is to contract with a design/build company that can manage all of the details for your remodel.
