

NOW WHAT?

I want to proceed with filing bankruptcy.

- Call 301.870.5417 or email us at customerservice@greismanlaw.com and request a “Get-Started” appointment.
- You will need to have a \$500 deposit during your Get-Started appointment. Ask about a payment plan.
- The checklist below will help you get the documents you will need for your Get-Started appointment.

What to expect:

At the appointment, we will ask questions and gather any documents you have. *(see document list below)*

For this appointment you should bring us as much documentation from the list below as you can.

The next 3 steps are;

1. Getting Started
2. Homework Due (gather documents and information we need)
3. Review your petition, Sign, and File electronically from here. *No need to file at court house for this.*

What to bring:

To comply with the bankruptcy laws and to allow us to evaluate your situation correctly, you will need to supply as much of the following information as possible.

Information Needed for your Get-Started Appointment

Don't worry if you don't have all the information ready, we can still start the process.

📄 Income documents Last 6-months for you and your spouse

(If filing single, your spouse's income documents will only be used to get your combined household income.)

- Paycheck\pay stubs\LES
- Unemployment benefits received for the last seven months.
- Pension\Retirement\Social Security benefits.
- Child or spousal support received from government\spouse\other *(court and non-court ordered)*
- Lease or rental income received.

📄 Car/motorcycle/ATV/Boat: Year/make/model/style/trim and mileage of any vehicle with your name on title. If filing joint, please provide this info on all spouses' vehicles.

📄 Bank interest income or stock dividend income received.

📄 Divorce\Separation agreement or papers

📄 Tax documents: Returns\Taxes owed for federal and state for the following years: 2017, 2016, 2015

📄 Documents regarding any foreclosures, lawsuits, repossessions, garnishments, evictions during the past year.

📄 Documents regarding personal and real property you own *(such as stock value statements, cash value life insurance policy documents, etc.)*

📄 Timeshare unit documents for all timeshares you or your spouse has their names on.

📄 Documents for\from an inheritance, estate or trust you have or may be part of.

📄 Education IRA, Education Saving Account or tuition program documentation.

📄 **Business Owners**, complete monthly break-out list, gross receipts, operational expenses, net profits, including a year-to-date or recent monthly Profit & Loss Statement. We can provide you with a business spreadsheet.
