*There will be information available to our residents with questions regarding the 2020 Census.*

#### **Things to know...**

- The 2020 Census survey will NOT be requiring any income related questions this year.
  - If we are not counted, the money that we pay—the taxes— goes somewhere else.
- An accurate count is important when applying for federal and state funding. Things like transportation, park projects and Community Development Block Grants are all based on per capita. The results from the 2010 Census account for about \$2,300 per person per year into Washington Communities.
  - Your information is protected by federal law, Title 44 of the U.S. code.
  - Watch for an additional mailer/invite later this month.

*Don't forget to "spring forward" and set your clocks an hour ahead for daylight savings time.*
