The State Corporation Commission's (SCC or Commission) Division of Utility and Railroad Safety (URS) seeks a highly professional and talented leader to serve as Deputy Director. As one of two Deputy Directors reporting to the Director of URS, this Deputy Director will have operational and managerial responsibilities over the Railroad Safety Program, the Training and Outreach Program, and the Systems Management Program within URS. The Deputy Director will support the Director in creating more structured governance and oversight over the three program areas listed above. The selected candidate for this Deputy Director position will also be responsible for: establishing goals, objectives, and management policies for URS. The selected candidate will also be responsible for monitoring and tracking changes to the railroad industry, including legislative updates, major railroad accidents, and federal rulemakings. In addition, this person will guide outreach initiatives related to underground utility industries and railroad safety; advise the Commission on matters concerning railroad safety; prepare and present testimony and reports before the Commission; and recommend solutions to address regulatory Other responsibilities will include: providing coaching, development and leadership to staff; reviewing reports and recommendations; working closely with state and federal agencies; reviewing proposed legislation and grant filings; and assisting in the preparation of legislation, opinions, and briefs. This position offers a hybrid work schedule (generally 3 days of telework and two days in-office per week) and a variety of professional development opportunities. Public presentations and travel are required.

Preferred qualifications for this position include considerable experience leading and directing the work of staff in a professional organization; experience leading project management initiatives; and a bachelor's degree. Experience in railroad safety, underground utility safety, systems management, and/or outreach and training is preferred but not required. Prior experience recommending and implementing user-friendly processes for individuals, industry, and other government agencies is important. Thorough knowledge of functions, mission, and purpose of the SCC and the federal and state agencies engaged in railroad safety is desirable.

The ideal candidate will have the ability to think strategically; delegate responsibility and review results to ensure deliverables are met; and make quality and timely decisions. In addition, the selected candidate will maintain effective working relationships with SCC staff; industry personnel; trade representatives; Virginia executive, legislative, and regulatory offices and agencies; and the general public. Applicants must have the ability to lead, coach, and develop professional staff. Excellent interpersonal and communication skills are essential.
