L'imaginaire fétichiste et affichiste de Clara travaille l'inconscient des gens, leurs pulsions et leur part onirique – les féconde.

On n'en sort comme d'un parc d'attractions imbriqué dans un rêve inquiétant truffé de cachettes secrètes, de tiroirs à double-fond, de chausse-trapes.

L'univers de Clara n'est pas sans évoquer le désordre juvénile quelque peu cauchemardesque du *Paprika* de Satoshi Kon, son délire fantastique et chamarré, paraphrélique, semblable à un miroir déformant de la galerie des glaces d'une fête foraine : c'est pourtant encore et toujours la réalité.

Réalité de Clara: espace pictural à mi-chemin entre l'enfance et l'adolescence, auquel se heurte la logique adulte en déroute ; un espace transitionnel où se déploient instincts, animalité, désirs viscéraux et fantasmes tenus secrets - ainsi que luer corollaire: les peurs enfantines, dont le pouvoir créatif et la puissance d'évocation n'ont pas d'égal.

Chahut Lunaire – *écrivaine*

The peoples' unconscious, their pulsions and their dreams get obsessed and impregnated with Clara's fetishist spiritual imagination.

They get out of it as they leave an amusement park, with a disturbing dream overlapping their minds, stuffed with secret hiding places, drawers with false bottoms, and pitfalls ...

Clara's universe evokes the youthful and somewhat nightmarish disorder of Satoshi Kon's *Paprika*, his fantastic and colored frenzy, like a distorting glass in the hall of mirrors at a funfair: yet, it still is reality.

Clara's reality: a pictorial space halfway between childhood and adolescence, against which the failing logical thoughts of adults come up. It is a transitional space where instincts, the animal side of mankind, its visceral urges, and secret fantasies take root, as a consequence of childhood fears, with their creative and evocative impact that is second to none.

フェティシストな想像世界をもち、ポスター画家であるクララは、人々の無意識、彼らの欲動、彼らの幻想の部分を豊かに描き出す。

私たちは、怪しい夢の錯綜から作り出されて、秘密の隠れ場、二重底の引き出しや落とし穴がたくさん詰まったテーマパークのように、そこから抜け出せない。

クララの持つ世界は、生き生きとした無秩序を想起させずにはいられない、少なからず今敏（こんさとし）氏の映画「パプリカ」に現れる悪夢のようであり、それは彼女の空想で飾り立てられた妄想であり、パラフレニックであり、縁日に見かけるミラーハウス内の曲面鏡に似ている：にもかかわらず、その世界はいつでも現実である。

クララの表現する現実は、ちょうど小さな子供から、大人の理屈にぶつかり狼狽してしまう思春期の若者の過渡期を描く絵画的空間である：そこには本能、人間の獸性、内に潜む欲望、そして秘密をはらんだ幻想が広がっている。 — したがって、それらの必然的な帰結：子供じみた恐怖の中にある創造力と喚起力とは一様ではない。










