
- > DNA analyses identify origins and trace the movement of domesticated livestock across time and space.
- Residues analysis can identify specific uses of animal products such as milk for cheese as well as to recognize storage vessels used for meats and fats.
- > Isotopic analysis of teeth can reveal grazing patterns and sources of winter fodder for livestock.
- > XRAY fluorescence on teeth can be used to distinguish locally raised animals from imported animals within a herd.
