The June tournaments were scheduled for a wildcard on June 10th and June 18th on Hamilton. Best producing baits were a green pumpkin trick worm on a jig head ,Other baits that were successful included a darter head jig with a salt and pepper dead ringer and wacky worm, top water and drop shot.

The top three Anglers for wildcard tournament were:

Dave Keith with 189 ounces, Kirk Bixler with 136 ounces and Darrell Graham with 104 ounces. The top three co-anglers for the wildcard were Juno Jamison with 116 ounces, Bob Brannan with 105 ounces and Pete DeVries with 90 ounces.

Big bass on the angler side went to Dave Keith with 55 ounces and a 3 way tie with 55 ounces went to Juno Jamison, Bob Brannan and Mike Ray.

The top three anglers for the June Hamilton tournament were: Kirk Bixler with 173 ounces, Frank Elliot with 166 ounces and Greg Osterhout with 136 ounces. On the co-angler side the top three were: Bob Brannan with 127 ounces, Mike Ray with 108 ounces and Jun Jamison with 104 ounces.
