We are so excited about our 2022 Performance Workshops!!!

We are thrilled to get your kids on stage in front of a LIVE audience again. In 2021, our workshops and camps had no LIVE audience. The shows were filmed and everyone received a FREE DVD or a download of their show. We are cautiously optimistic that things are getting better, so we are putting them back in front of an audience again. However, if we start to see things go south, we will go back to filming the show with no audience. Below are the guidelines for the 'new normal. As we all know, (and have lived through several times over the past couple of years), things may change and we are ready to adapt. The most important part is keeping the kids safe AND getting them back to the stage and having some fun. After you have read everything below, go back to the WORKSHOP / DRAMA CAMP page of the web site and use the form to register. 1) SO, WHAT IS THIS WORKSHOP ALL ABOUT and WHAT DOES IT OFFER?

On the first day the kids will be asked to sing a one minute song for the auditions. We then take them through some acting exercises where they get to perform commercials with their fellow cast members. We then cast the show; pass out their scripts and music. The second day of class we start putting their show together! Every class we will try to do a craft that ties in with the show - costume design, make-up design; a specialty prop. etc.

2) COVID PROTOCOLS

Temperatures will be taken before the actor can enter the rehearsal space. Only the kids in the workshop will be allowed in the theater during the rehearsal process. However, Mom and Dad may walk them to the check in table located outside the theater to sign them in. Everyone who enters the theater will be required to wear a mask during the rehearsals AND performances. This includes audience members during performances. Each workshop will be limited to 25 kids and everyone will be assigned a chair that they will use from class to class. We have 60 total chairs in the Broadway Theater and we are able to maintain an adequate spacing for the 25 performers. The theater, the actor's chairs and restrooms will be sanitized prior to the each workshop session AND sanitized between all performances. During the two hours the kids are with us, the restrooms are cleaned on the hour.

3) PERFORMANCE / REHEARSAL DATES AND TIMES FOR 'MERMAID'

Rehearsal Days: May 23, 25, 27, June 1, 3, 6, 8 and 9 from 4:30 to 6:00 p.m. **Show Days:** June 10th -7:00 p.m. show / June 11th - 2:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. shows / June 12th - 2:00 p.m. show

4) PERFORMANCES

As was mentioned above, The Broadway Theater has 60 seats - but we will only be selling 50 tickets to each of the four shows. If we have 25 kids register for this workshop each child will get 8 tickets to sell. If we get 20 kids registered each child will get 10 tickets to sell. If we get 15 kids enrolled each child will get 13 tickets to sell. Ticket sales are first come first serve. The earlier you get your tickets in, the better chances you will have at getting the date and time of the show you want. The TICKET SALES SHEET will be given out on the first day of the workshop. Tickets are \$7.00 per person.

5) HOW DO I REGISTER and WHAT IS THE COST FOR ENROLLMENT?

The cast fee is \$150.00 per child enrolled. To sign your child up, you can use the REGISTRATION FORM located on the DRAMA CAMP/WORKSHOP page of our web site. 6) WHAT DO I NEED TO SEND WITH MY CHILD TO EACH CLASS?

Below are the items your child needs to provide every week:

A small snack.

A water bottle.

3 ring binder (for their script).

Two sharpened pencils.

Crayons and colored markers for craft projects. Scissors for craft projects.

Hand Sanitizer.

We have a TON of it, but we would like the kids to provide as well.
