ORDINANCE NUMBER 620

In the City of Garnett
An ordinance providing for the improvement of Oak Street, from the north side
of Second Avenue in said City to the north end of Oak Street, and ordering
the grading, curbing, guttering and paving of the same and providing for the
cest thereof.

WHEREAS, a majority of the resident property owners fronting on Oak Street, in the City of Garnett, in Anderson County, Kansas, from the north side of Second Avenue, in said City to the north end of Oak Street, have signed a petition to the board of commissioners of said City to have said Oak Street, from the north side of Second Avenue, in said City, to the north end of said Oak Street graded, graded, curbed, guttered and paved, from the north side of Second Avenue, in said City to the north end of said Oak Street, and said petition having been presented to said board and said board having carefully examined and investigated said petition as to the sufficiency thereof find that a majority of the resident owners of property abutting on said Street from the north side of Second Avenue to the north end of said Oak Street have signed said petition, and said improvement being deemed necessary:

Therefore, Be it ordained by the beard of commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

curbing, guttering and paving said street and for doing all grading and excavating for the same, except for the squares and areas formed by the intersection of First Avenue, after the same has been brought to grade as provided by law the assessment shall be made for each block separately on all lets to the cen-

ter of the block on either side of said street the distance to be improved, acer parcels of ground cording to the assessed value of the lots without regard to the buildings and improvements thereon, which value shall be ascertained by three disinterested appraisers appointed by the board of commissioners. And the said board of commissioners shall provide for the cost of said improvements in ten installments of equal amounts, payable one each year, from one to ten years. Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate not to exceed five and one half per cent per annum, and said interest shall be payable semi-annually. For each of said installments of interest on all sums unpaid, coupons shall be attached to said bends. Special assessments shall be made upon the preperty chargeable for the cost of such improvement, and levied and collected against each lot above named according to the assessed valuation thereof as hereinafter provided, but the assessed valuation of the property liable to such cost which is established for the first year's assessment shall be retained for the assessment for the succeeding installments of such bonds. The owner of any lot liable to such assessment may, at any time within thirty days after the amount due from such let is ascertained and before the bends herein provided for are issued pay his proportion of such assessment to the city treasurer, and his preperty so paid shall net be thereafter p liable for any further assessment for the cost of said work, nor for said bonds. That for the purpose of providing for the payment of the cost of paving and improving the squares and areas formed by the intersection tion of First Avenue and for the construction and adjusting of all sidewalk extensions from lot to eurb lines the grading and finishing of all parking, the construction of needed eatch basins and extensions, and bringing said avenue to grade, an assessment shall be made on all the taxable property of the city, and the board of commissioners shall issue special improvement bonds of said city and levy taxes and assessments in addition to all other taxes and assessments new authorized by law, to pay said bonds and the interest thereon. Said bonds shall be issued in ten equal amounts payable one each year from one to ten years said bonds shall bear interest at not to exceed five and one half per cent per annum, and said interest shall be payable semi-annually. For each of said install ments of interest on all sums unpaid, coupons shall be attached to said bonds. Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law.
